#### Craft 64 (68 E Buffalo St.)

No matter how you slice it, Craft 64's rotating selection of 30+ Arizona craft beers and highquality dishes have a pizza of our heart. Getting hungry? Enjoy wood-fired pizzas made with local organic ingredients and made scratch mozzarella. We also love their bruschetta, salads and desserts.



# SanTan Brewery (8 S. San Marcos Pl.)

What would a beer crawl be without a stop into SanTan Brewing? Their main line of brews is available year-round and include the 1920 Lager, Juicy Jack Hazy IPA, HefeWeizen, Moon Juice IPA, HopeShock IPA and Devil's Ale Pale Ale. Depending on the time of year you can even try out seasonal favorites like Oktoberfest, Mr. Pineapple and Sex Panther. In terms of bites, enjoy a full menu of sandwiches, burgers, pizza and more.



#### Pedal Haus Brewery (95 W. Boston St.)

New kid on the Downtown Chandler block! The accolades are endless for Pedal Haus Brewery, but one of the highest was being named "Best Brewery in the U.S." at the Copa Cervezas de Americas 2019. Here you'll find 13 in-house brews plus local collaborations. The food menu includes Nashville hot chicken, fish & chips and Thai peanut salmon salad. Catch live music while vou're there too.



## The Perch Pub & Brewery (232 S. Wall St.)

In addition to 40 (that's right) craft beers that include their own brews plus local and crowd favorites. The Perch is also home to a collection of over 50 tropical rescue birds. Ask to sit on the rooftop patio so you can take in Downtown Chandler in all of its glory. You'll also enjoy live music Thursday-Saturday. Grab a bite to eat from the extensive menu that suits any pallet.



## The Sleepy Whale (290 S Arizona Ave.)

Next let's head over to The Sleepy Whale, a beer and bottle shop where you'll have access to a rotating selection of on-tap and canned beers from local and out of state breweries. They also make their own brew. In fact, once a month Sleepy Whale staff have a "brew day" with other local breweries where they select the style of beer and hops, then set to work brewing their collaboration. To date, collabs include Arizona Wilderness, Pedal Haus Brewery, Helton, The Shop and more.



#### QuartHaus (201 S. Washington St.)

Still with us? QuartHaus is the final stop on our beer trail, but you'll definitely be glad you came here as it's the first "brewstillery" in the downtown. Choose from 25 independent craft beers on tap, 8 wines on tap or their small batch vodka, made with 80% corn and 20% barley filtered through charcoal. Enjoy the begutiful weather by sitting on the patio complete with games, a basketball court, cornhole and live music on some weekends.
